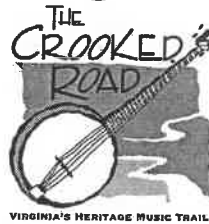


2018-192562 Scott County JAMS – A Crooked Road/JAM Program



Scott County JAMS is an after-school program designed to enrich a new generation with our cultural heritage through music education.

We are excited to begin Scott County JAMS. This program serves youth in grades four through twelve. Scott County JAMS seeks to preserve our Appalachian music heritage by offering low cost classes in fiddle, banjo, guitar, and mandolin to students in an after-school setting. We may be able to offer lessons to parents/guardians/grandparents in this group setting if there is an interest and open slots.

Classes will begin Thursday **October 4, 2018**, and will run through **December 13th, 2018**. Classes will be held at Shoemaker Elementary on Thursdays from 3:30 – 5:30 pm. Youth who attend these classes are encouraged to attend all weekly classes. **Transportation will not be provided.** Parents will need to pick up students at 5:30 pm Thursdays

Costs will be kept low. Class fees help cover costs to operate the program. Instruments will be provided on a loan basis as supply allows. If your child has their own instrument they may be able to use it. Instructors will look at these and let you know.
