Welcome to Scott County Schools SOAR Program.

Scott County Schools offers students distance learning opportunities through SOAR (Student Online Academic Recovery) Program Using academic curriculum from Edgenunity that is aligned to the Virginia standards of learning. Students may enroll and receive standard credits upon completion of courses. In addition, students may receive verified credits upon passing the SOL test corresponding to the courses completed. These courses present educational material to students using online resources, and the course is supervised by licensed teachers approved by the local school board. This program is available at no cost to students enrolled in Scott county Schools, and is designed to meet the needs of students who otherwise would not be able to take certain classes due to lack of availability or scheduling conflicts. Due to the current COVID-19 Pandemic, The SOAR Program can be used for high quality virtual learning experience for an entire semester schedule of classes.

Within the Edgenuity Program, students will have access to high quality instruction, activities, and evaluations. Both students and parents have access to the student's progress, current grade, hours remaining to completion, and communication to the teacher assigned to each course.
