APPROVAL OF SALARY SCALES FOR 2005-06 SCHOOL YEAR:

Superintendent Scott informed board members that school personnel would receive a 5% salary increase or \$1,200.00, whichever is greater. On the recommendation of Superintendent Scott and on a motion by Mr. Campbell, seconded by Mr. Sampson, all members voting aye, the board approved the salary scales for the 2005-06 school year as submitted. APPROVAL OF SCHOOL BUDGET FOR 2005-06 SCHOOL YEAR:

Superintendent Scott informed board members that he is requesting approval of the school budget in order to send it to the County Board of Supervisors for their meeting next week and stated he hopes that they would send something back so that contracts can be sent out soon. On the recommendation of Superintendent Scott and on a motion by Mr. McMurray, seconded by Mr. Sampson, all members voting aye, the board approved the 2005-06 School Budget as presented. The 2005-06 School Budget is based on 3,680 Average Daily Membership (ADM). (Appendix B)

He reported that it may be necessary to add one or two additional teachers at Gate City Middle School due to the number of current and upcoming 7th grade students.
