APPROVAL OF GRADUATION DATES: Superintendent Scott informed board members that currently the last day of school is Monday, May 29 and recommended that high school graduations be held as follows: Gate City High School, Friday, May 26, 7 p.m.; Rye Cove High School, Saturday, May 27, 10 a.m.; and Twin Springs High School, Monday, May 29, 7 p.m. On the recommendation of Superintendent Scott and on a motion by Mr. Meade, seconded by Mrs. Blair, all members voting aye, the board approved graduation dates as presented.

DISCUSSION OF AND APPROVAL OF ADDITIONAL SCHOOL NURSES FOR 2006-07 SCHOOL YEAR: Superintendent Scott reported that the number of students needing medical assistance at the schools is increasing each year. He stated that there are other things that need to be done as well but maybe it is just as important to use funds to hire additional nursing staff for the schools. He reported that sometimes it is difficult at the schools, due to the territory to cover, to take care of the needs. He stated that the school division is in pretty good shape money-wise and can hire additional nurses if the board wishes to do so. He presented a lists of options for providing coverage at the schools should no additional personnel be hired; or by adding one, two, or three additional nurses. He explained that the options presented were just a proposal and that a decision could be made based on what the board chooses regarding additional nurses and a final plan can be presented at a later date.

Mr. Kindle made a motion that the Superintendent hire three additional nurses, motion was seconded by Mr. Sampson, all members voting aye.

APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN SCOTT COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD AND SCOTT COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE AUTHORITY FOR WATER SERVICE EXTENSION TO RYE COVE HIGH SCHOOL AND RYE COVE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL: Superintendent Scott reported on the progress of the Rye Cove water project and explained that the project should be completed by the beginning of next school year as previously discussed. He asked Mr. C. Dean Foster, Jr., County Attorney, to explain and answer questions regarding the proposed Agreement Between Scott County School Board and Scott County Public Service Authority for Water Service Extension to Rye Cove High School and Rye Cove Intermediate School. County Attorney Foster clarified labor cost concerns and stated that if there were any changes made to the agreement, he would inform the necessary parties. On the recommendation of Superintendent Scott and on a motion by Mr. Kindle, seconded by Mrs. Blair, all members voting aye, the board approved the Agreement Between Scott County School Board and Scott County Public Service Authority for a Water Service Extension to Rye Cove High School and Rye Cove Intermediate School.

MAINTENANCE UPDATE: Superintendent Scott provided an update on the progress of the Duffield, Shoemaker, and Alternative Education classroom projects. He explained that it will be necessary to contract some of the work for the Shoemaker project and that the Alternative Education classroom project is basically complete. He reported that the window project at Fort Blackmore Primary School is being completed this week. He explained that with completion of the window projects, the major school facility projects have been completed at the schools but he stated that the facilities will be reviewed county-

wide. He explained about a delay with receiving the blinds and that they will hopefully be here by May 10. He stated plans to probably get started on the gym facilities after the Shoemaker Elementary School and Duffield Primary School classrooms are completed.

Mr. Campbell expressed that it is important that the maintenance department doesn't get behind with the air conditioning maintenance projects at the schools.

#### APPROVAL OF ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING PROFESSIONAL

CONSULTING SERVICES: Superintendent Scott reported that three companies provided proposals for architectural and engineering professional consulting services and that the interview committee felt that all three companies had good presentations. He reported that the committee felt that Beeson, Lusk and Street, and Appalachian Technical Service would better meet the school division's needs at this time. On the recommendation of the committee and Superintendent Scott and ,on a motion by Mr. Meade, seconded by Mr. Sampson, all members voting aye, the board approved Beeson, Lusk and Street of Johnson City, Tennessee and Appalachian Technical Services, Wise and Abingdon, Virginia, to provide architectural and engineering professional consulting services.

APPROVAL OF LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FOR NON-EMPLOYMENT OF NON-CERTIFICATED TEACHERS FOR 2006-07 SCHOOL YEAR: Superintendent Scott explained that the following personnel were being recommended for non-employment for the 2006-07 school year at this time; however, should they finish all legally necessary state certification prior to August 10, their employment may be possible for the 2006-07 school year. On the recommendation of Superintendent Scott and on a motion by Mrs. Blair, seconded by Mr. Kindle, all members voting aye, the board approved the non-renewal of contracts for Matthew Bays, Sarah Grimes, Janet Davidson, and Lowell Fowler, for the 2006-07 school year pursuant to Va. Code Section 22.1-305(E).

# RECOGNITION OF SCOTT COUNTY CAREER & TECHNICAL CENTER'S SKILLS USA STUDENTS: The Scott County Career & Technical Center's Skills USA students introduced

themselves and informed the board of their wins in the regional competitions as follows:

Mr. Ralph Quesinberry, Scott County Career & Technical Center Vocational Director/Principal, expressed pride for the students' achievement. He explained that the students have fundraising for their trips, which includes the fruit sales. Mr. Quesinberry stated that he is proud of the new jackets that the students will be wearing to the state competitions. He reported that the first place winners will be traveling to the state competitions and that these students will represent the school division well. Mr. Quesinberry also reported that there was one other Skills USA winner, Jerad Alley, who won First Place in the Poster Contest, was unable to attend tonight's meeting.
