SCOTT COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD MINUTES OF 2005-06 SCHOOL BUDGET CLOSE-OUT MEETING THURSDAY, JUNE 29, 2006

The Scott County School Board met in a close-out meeting for the 2005-06 School Budget on Thursday, June 29, 2006, at the Scott County School Board Office in Gate City, Virginia, with the following members present:

<u>APPOINTMENT OF PRO-TEM CHAIRMAN</u>: In the absence of the Chairman and Vice Chairman there was discussion to whether a board member was to serve as Pro-Tem Chairman. Board members decided that in the absence of the Chairman and Vice Chairman, Superintendent Scott would serve as Pro-Tem Chairman.

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Mr. James B. Scott, Division Superintendent, serving as Pro-Tem Chairman in the absence of the chairman and vice chairman, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and presided.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: On a motion by Mr. Sampson, seconded by Mr. Kindle, all members voting aye, the board approved the agenda as submitted.

APPROVAL OF CLAIMS AND CLOSE OUT OF 2005-06 SCHOOL BUDGET:

On a motion by Mrs. Blair, seconded by Mr. McMurray, all members voting aye, the board approved the carryover of School Construction Fund revenue in the amount of \$11.31 and including the amount of the June interest upon receipt and claims as follows: School Operating Fund invoices in the amount of \$326,393.97 as shown by warrants #8076275-8076394 (8076282, 8076283 & 8076284 voided). School Improvement/Construction Fund invoices in the amount of \$7,723.36 as shown by warrants #1900403 &

1900404. Cafeteria Auxiliary Fund invoices in the amount of \$937.51 as shown by warrants #1008724-1008729.

APPROVAL OF PAYMENT OF EARLY INVOICES RESOLUTION: Superintendent Scott informed board members of the changes made to the Payment of Early Invoices Resolution, which the school board reviews and approves annually. He explained that Duffield Development Authority was deleted, Sprint name changed to Embarq, Virginia School Boards Association deleted, and Virginia State Police added. On the recommendation of Superintendent Scott and on a motion by Mr. Kindle, seconded by Mr. McMurray, all members voting aye, the board approved the Payment of Early Invoices Resolution as follows:

WHEREAS, the Scott County School Board desires to practice financial accountability, and WHEREAS, certain invoices are of the nature that add interest charges and additional late charges for the registration fees after a prescribed number of days, and

WHEREAS, certain invoices have a discount applied if paid within a prescribed number of days, and WHEREAS, these interest, late, and additional charges are viewed as unnecessary expense,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Scott County School Board authorized the Superintendent and Clerk of the Board to approve and to forward legitimate Alltel, AT&T, American Electric Power Company, Bristol Virginia Utilities Board, Chevron, Division of Motor Vehicles, Dungannon Water Department, Exxon Company, Gate City Water Department, MBNA America (Mastercard) Platinum Plus for Business, MountaiNet, Nickelsville Water Department, Office Depot, Office Max, Phillips 66 Company, Powell Valley Electric Company, Scott County Telephone Cooperative, Scott County Public Service Authority, Scott Telecom & Electronics, Embarq Virginia State Police, newspaper invoices, Board approved and/or bidden contracted maintenance/construction invoices, architect and engineering invoices, insurance and Board invoices, registration fees, invoices stating discounts, textbook invoices, and invoices to be used for reimbursement purposes that need to be paid before the next regular meeting to the county administrator for payment.
