Due to changes in the accreditation requirements from the State. We would like to recommend the following changes to our attendance policy:

I have attached a recommended addition to our attendance policy for secondary students and the current chronic absenteeism rate for the 2017-2018 school year and the 2018-2019 school year.

# Additions to Policy JED for High School Students:

# A. Requirements for Participation in the following:

## 1. ATHLETICS

 Must be present at school for 2 blocks to play or practice with a parent note or 1 block with a doctor excuse

#### 2. Prom

 Any student that is absent from school 15 or more days will not be eligible for prom.

## 3. Senior Trip (if applicable)

- A student who is absent from school 15 or more days during the school year is not eligible to participate in senior trip
- Must meet all deadlines set forth by sponsors

## 4. Fall Formal (if applicable)

• A student who is absent from school 7 or more days is not eligible to attend the fall formal.
