Separate sealed Bids for the Track Surfacing at Scott County Sports Complex for the Scott County Public Schools consisting of the preparation and installation of a new track surface over the existing asphalt, including high jump, long jump, and triple jump tracks, will be received by Robert Sallee, Maintenance Supervisor, at the office of the Scott County School Board 340 East Jackson St. Gate City, VA, until 2:00 P.M., local prevailing time, on December 12, 2023, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held on November 28, 2023 at 9:30 A.M. All interested parties are requested to meet the Architect at the project site at that time.

Withdrawal of bids shall be according to procedure (i) of the Virginia Public Procurement Act and to the Code of Virginia (§ 2.2-4330). Any Bidder must give notice in writing of its claim of right to withdraw its Bid within two business days after the conclusion of the Bid Opening Procedure. If a Bid is withdrawn, the next higher Bidder shall be deemed to be the Low Bidder. No Bid may be withdrawn unless said withdrawal is permitted by law.

Bids must be accompanied by Bid security as specified in the Instructions to Bidders.

Each Bidder must be licensed as a Class A contractor in the State of Virginia; Bidders are instructed to review the *Code of Virginia*, Title 54.1, Chapter 11, prior to bidding.
