


Parents Have Options

RETURN TO SCHOOL

- Students will return to school under Plan A and SCPS will implement all safety guidelines outlined in the Reopening Plan document.
- Parents may request anytime for a student to move to the virtual option.
- If Governor moves Virginia to Phase 1, students will go to REMOTE learning, which is led by the classroom teacher and is not the same as Virtual.

100% VIRTUAL

- Parents should <u>contact school principal</u> for information.
- A division representative will contact parent to enroll student(s) in the SCPS Virtual School Program.
- Students will receive Chromebook and applicable textbooks/resources
- K-7 Classes will be enrolled in Virtual Virginia and monitored by SCPS Elementary Virtual Team
- 8-12 Classes will be enrolled in Edgeunity and monitored by SCPS High School Virtual Team
- Once enrolled in the virtual program it is required for the entire semester.



Cleaning & Disinfecting

- Buses will be cleaned after morning and afternoon runs.
- Classrooms and materials will be cleaned daily.
- Schools will be deep cleaned 2 X weekly.
- Restrooms will be checked and cleaned throughout the day, with limited capacity for social distancing.
- Communal areas will be cleaned throughout the day.

Health Screening

STAFF:

- required to perform self-check (temperature and symptoms)
 prior to reporting to school daily
- required to document and retain Self-Check Monthly Forms

STUDENTS:

- Parents should assess students' temperature and symptoms prior to reporting to school daily.
- Temperatures will be taken upon arrival at school daily

Arrival & Dismissal

ARRIVAL:

- Students will be health screened
- Students will report directly to their first assigned class
- Breakfast will be Grab and Go (eaten in the classroom)
- Teachers and staff will be in classrooms and hallways to supervise

DISMISSAL:

- PreK and Kindergarten students who are car-riders will be dismissed first
- Each school will create a plan to dismiss students in small groups for buses, pick-up, etc.
- Students who need to be checked out early should call the school office upon arrival to the school. Office staff will escort student to main entrance to verify identity


- Face Coverings worn when social distancing of 6 feet isn't feasible

COVID-19

- If an employee or student displays symptoms consistent with COVID-19 at school, he/she will immediately report to the school's isolation room, be provided PPE, and asked to follow the protocol established by the Virginia Department of Health.
- In the event a student or staff member is diagnosed with COVID-19, the Virginia Department of Health will identify the appropriate closure of classrooms &/or schools.
- Plan D: Remote Learning will be implemented for any classroom/school/division closure.
